### What are anti-wrinkle injections?

## Frequently Asked Questions

### How long does it take?

Each session takes approximately 20-30 minutes although the injection process itself only takes a few minutes.

The session involves Dr Zena making a series of small shallow injections into the muscles of your face.

Dr Zena's Botulinum toxin of choice is Azzalure® by Galderma.

### What areas can benefit from an anti-wrinkle injection?

Anti-wrinkle injections are most effective when used to reduce the signs of ageing and skin wrinkles in the following areas:

- Forehead/brow (horizontal forehead lines)
- Between the eyebrows (frown lines)
- Sides of the eyes (crows feet)

### Can I go back to work afterwards?

Yes, usually straight away.

### Will I need anaesthetic?

No local anaesthetic is necessary.

### What is the usual time to full recovery?

Around 24 hours.

### What is the initial sensitivity period?

Usually there is no sensitivity, but if it occurs it should be gone within 1 hour.

### How long will the results last?

We expect the results to last 3-4 months\*

### When will I notice an improvement in my wrinkles?

This differs between individuals but usually after 4 to 10 days you will notice an improvement in your lines/wrinkles, and this will last approximately 3-4 months.\*

### What are the risks & complications?

There are risks with any procedure to the human body. Most side effects are short-lived and mild, the most common being mild bruising at the site of the injections. Some patients also report mild headaches shortly after the treatment, but these usually subside within 24 hours. Complications are not common however they include: infection, bruises, drooping of the eyebrow, allergic reactions (e.g. swelling)\*
